The exhibition at Fenton House concentrates on Armando's photographic documentary of daily life in three monasteries in Egmond, Netherlands. Egmond contains three different communities: Egmond aan Zee (6.000 people), Egmond aan den Hoef (2.500 people) and Egmond-Binnen (3.000 people). Armando was born in Egmond aan Zee and has lived there almost his whole life. He states "If you are travelling abroad, everything is new and you recognise what is interesting or what makes a good picture. In your own village you have to look in a new way".

Armando Jongejan FRPS (1960) studied Photography at the Photo academy in Apeldoorn the Netherlands and works as a freelance photographer.
